JUNIOR BASEBALL ORGANIZATION PLAYER/TEAM ELIGIBILITY RULES

Following are important excerpts from the Junior Baseball Organization (JBO) rulebook. Refer to the JBO “Official Rules and Regulations” for the most current rules and complete guidance on player and team eligibility.

I. TEAM ELIGIBILITY

- B. Minimum number of players on each team roster must be twelve (12). In addition, teams entering State Tournament play must bring a roster with 12 eligible players or provide the appropriate “Player/Team Waiver Form” (See section I and V for additional information).
- C. Each team accepted for participation in Junior Baseball must file a team roster and any waivers required, to their District Commissioner no later than their first league game. The Commissioner will then submit those rosters to the State Vice President...
- D. Additions to team rosters after their first league game will only be allowed prior to completing fifty percent (50%) of the team’s League games. Players may not move between team rosters without a waiver of the District Commissioner on the appropriate “Player/Team Waiver Form”... All players are still subject to the “player eligibility” requirements in order to participate in the State Tournament... Players added after fifty percent (50%) of the team’s league games require a waiver of the District Commissioner on the appropriate “Player/Team Waiver Form.” Player will be considered an eligible player for the remainder of the season; however, the team is no longer eligible for any post-season play. Not subject to appeal. A revised Team Roster with any appropriate waivers must be submitted to the State Vice President before additions are eligible to participate.

II. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- B. A waiver is required for a player who elects to play in another Association other than the one in which they reside.
- D. If a player is found to be playing outside of the Association in which she/he resides and a completed waiver form is not on file with the team roster, the player will be declared ineligible and all games in which she/he has played in will be forfeited. The player will be eligible as soon as the waiver form is signed by both Associations, District Commissioner and is on file with the team roster.

- E. Any player not residing within the boundaries of a current Junior Baseball Association must play in the Association closest to their residence, unless waived by that Association.
- F. If an Association does not field a Federal team, players in that Association may play in the Association closest to their residence and within the player's district of residence at the Federal level without a waiver.
- G. If a team has won a game using an ineligible player, the game is to be forfeited to the opposing team except that illegal substitution shall not be grounds for forfeiture.
- I. Any player on a team roster must have played in at least fifty percent (50%) of the team's League games in order to participate in the State Tournament. Submit excuses to the appropriate District Commissioner to have approved by the State Board at the State Tournament Meeting.
Exception: Illness or injury excused in writing by the player's doctor. Submit to and approved by the appropriate District Commissioner on the appropriate "Player/Team Waiver Form."

IMPORTANT NOTE CONCERNING RULE "I. D. TEAM ELIGIBILITY":

In addition to being ineligible for the State Tournament, a team adding a player to their roster after 50% of the league games have been played will **not** be eligible to participate in the Clackamas County District Tournament.

CLACKAMAS COUNTY JUNIOR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Coaches ejected from any game will be automatically suspended from coaching at their next League, District Tournament, or State tournament game (whichever comes first). Coaches must also provide proof of a current coach's card/certification to the County Board before being reinstated. Coaches may appeal this penalty, but the game suspension must be served. A successful appeal may lessen the potential penalty associated with additional infractions (see next provision). Coaches ejected twice during a season will be required to appear before the County Board for possible disciplinary action (unless the initial penalty appeal is ruled in favor of the coach). Discipline could range from a multiple game suspension to removal from coaching. When serving a game suspension, the coach may watch the game from the general spectator area, but must not be in the bench area or coach from any area during the game.

Players ejected from a game will be subject to similar penalties. Any player ejected from a game is automatically required to be benched at the next League, District Tournament, or State Tournament game (whichever comes first). The player must attend the game to serve the penalty. If the player does not attend the next applicable game, the suspension will continue to apply until the player has attended, and been benched for an entire game. To document that the suspension has been served, the players coach must assure that the name of the suspended player is recorded in the opposing team's scorebook with a clear notation that the player is being "benched for disciplinary reasons." Players ejected a second time will be required to appear before the County Board. Subsequent discipline could range from multiple game suspensions to removal from participation in Junior Baseball games for the remainder of the season.

When a player is ejected, it is the responsibility of his/her coach to assure that the player serves the automatic game suspension at the next League, District Tournament, or State Tournament game. If the player participates in subsequent League, District Tournament, or State Tournament games without serving this penalty, the players team may be required to forfeit all games that the player participated in prior to the penalty being completed.

The Clackamas County Junior Baseball Board may impose disciplinary action on coaches or players for improper behavior, disregard for game rules, or other conduct contrary to the intent and philosophies of the Junior Baseball Organization, and this organization. This may include improper actions and behaviors not specifically mentioned in this code.

CCJBA TEAM AND GAME REQUIREMENTS

The participation fee for each team in all age divisions is \$105.

All games shall be played in accordance with “*Junior Baseball Organization Official Rules and Regulations.*” Consult this book for a complete set of rules.

Coaches must provide a complete line-up card to the home plate umpire before the beginning of each game. The card must include the uniform number and complete name (first and last name) of all players participating in the game, and the complete name of the head coach present at the game.

Each home team is responsible for furnishing two (2) new, good quality, leather baseballs for each game.

All rainouts or game cancellations must be rescheduled within seven (7) days. The home team must offer three possible dates for the visiting team coach to accept.

There will be no game protests to the County Board. For disputes over rule interpretation during a game, coaches will have two minutes to identify to the umpire the rule in question from the official rule book(s). The coach must have the applicable rulebook in possession before disputing an umpire interpretation.

Opposing coaches should show sportsmanship by working together to solve rule interpretation conflicts.

RULES FOR DOUBLE-HEADERS DURING LEAGUE PLAY:

- 1) For the first game, the game shall start by 6 p.m. and no inning will begin after 8:00 p.m.
- 2) The second game will begin no later than 20 minutes after completion of the first game, and no earlier than 7:30 p.m.
- 3) For the second game, no inning will begin after 10:45 p.m.
- 4) Any inning that is begun before these time limits will be completed if possible. If, for some circumstance, the game is called during an inning, the score will revert back to the last complete inning.

CCJBA UMPIRE INFORMATION

Intimidation, threats, verbal abuse or physical contact with any umpire by coaches, players, or fans WILL NOT be tolerated. Severe disciplinary action will be imposed for any of these infractions.

Coaches and fans must remember that many of the umpires at these youth games are young teenagers, and are just learning to be umpires. Coaches are expected to exhibit patience, tolerate mistakes, and assist the umpire in learning. Failure to treat umpires with respect and promote a positive experience for these umpires leads to a lack of umpires for games!

The Area of the home team is responsible for scheduling and paying umpires for the game.

All umpires must be at least age 14 by August 1, 2009. In addition, an umpire must be at least two years older than the oldest players in the game: umpires must be at least 14 years of age for Midget and Junior level games, and at least 16 years of age for Senior level games.

All umpires used in league games must be certified by CCJBA or another recognized umpire association (e.g. Portland Baseball Umpires Assn., Salem Umpires Assn.).

CCJBA umpires receive certification by attending CCJBA sponsored clinics and passing a certification test. The certification test used to evaluate a potential umpires understanding of baseball rules is the same test that is administered to High School umpires!

REPORTING GAME RESULTS

All coaches will be provided with “mail-in” game results reporting cards.

The Home Team is responsible for completing the game results card during the game.

Game results cards must be signed by both coaches prior to leaving the field.

The game results card will be provided to the Winning coach who is responsible for mailing in the card.

In the case of a tie, the home team coach is responsible for mailing the card.

Game results cards must be completed **in full**, and be postmarked within 48 hours of the game.

Coaches must assure that completed cards include the score of the game, and the number of innings pitched by each pitcher for each team (Note: one pitch constitutes an inning pitched). For each pitcher, the card must note their uniform number, their first **and** last name, and the number of innings pitched.

Innings pitched in an official game that ends in a tie count against the pitchers total allowed innings.

A game is legal after three (3) innings for Midgets, four (4) innings for Juniors, and five (5) innings for Seniors and Cubs.

ALL game results cards must be received no later than:

9 p.m., July 3 (Midget National, Midget American, Midget Federal, Junior National, and Junior American)

9 p.m., July 10 (Junior Federal, Senior National, Senior American, and Senior Federal)

Note: It may be necessary for some teams to play “pre-tournament” games to qualify for the County Tournament “final eight.” In general, these games are scheduled on the weekdays immediately prior to the above noted tournament dates.

COUNTY TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

All federal teams are eligible for post-season County Tournament play. Only the top eight teams, or 50% of National and American level teams (whichever is greater) will be eligible. Tournament seeding is completed by the County Board based on each team's League win/loss record (percentage). League Champions receive the highest seeds. Teams that are moved **down** in skill level during the season are **not eligible** to be League Champion. Teams that are moved **up** in skill level during the season remain **eligible** to be League Champion. The win/loss record of moved teams is based on games after the move.

For County Tournament "pre-tournament" games, the higher seeded team will be the home team. **Both teams will split the umpire fees, and provide baseballs for these games.**

"Pre-tournament" innings pitched will not count against County Tournament games during the "final 8" weekend tournament.

Game Results Reporting Cards must be completed for all "pre-tournament" games. These cards will be kept by the winning coach and submitted to the County Board at the applicable Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting.

There is no time limit for "pre-tournament" games.

The Head Coach of all teams advancing to the "final 8" of the County Tournament must attend a **Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting**. If the Head Coach cannot attend, one team representative must attend in his/her place. For 2009, these meetings will be held as follows: **July 8 (Midget Federal), July 10 (Midget and Junior National), July 15 (Junior and Senior Federal), and July 17 (Senior National)**; meetings are at **6:30 pm, Chapin Park in Oregon City**. All **American** level teams will meet with tournament coordinators at the tournament site prior to their first game.

All teams advancing to the "final eight" of the County Tournament are required to pay an entry fee prior to the tournament. This fee must be paid to the Area hosting the tournament **at the Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting**. The entry fee is **\$50 for Midget and Junior National** teams, **\$75 for Midget and Junior American** teams, **\$125 for Midget and Junior Federal** teams, **\$100 for Senior National** teams, and **\$150 for Senior American and Federal** teams.}

Teams advancing to the "final 8" County Tournament that are not able to participate in the State Tournament must notify the County Board prior to, or at the beginning of, the County Tournament. These teams will be allowed to fully participate in the County Tournament, but if they qualify for State the berth will be provided to the next highest placing team; subsequent berths to State will be adjusted accordingly, if applicable.

Trophies: Each League Champion receives a team trophy. Team trophies are also presented to the 1st through 3rd place teams at the County Tournament. The 1st place team also receives individual player trophies.

COUNTY TOURNAMENT GAME RULES

- 1) Teams must play with the eligible players on their official state roster.
- 2) To be eligible for County Tournament play, a youth must have played in at least fifty percent (50%) of the teams regularly scheduled League games (exception: illness or injury must be excused in writing by the players doctor).
- 3) The home team will be decided at each game by a coin flip.
- 4) Infield warm-up will be limited to time available.
- 5) The 10-run rule applies, except in the championship game.
- 6) At the Federal and American levels, pitchers are allowed to pitch six (6) innings for Midgets, seven (7) innings for Juniors, and eight (8) innings for Seniors for every two consecutive games played. In **addition** to the above, National level players must not pitch more than three (3) innings for Midgets, four (4) innings for Juniors, and four (4) innings for Seniors per game.
- 7) There is no time limit on games (including County Tournament “pre-tournament” games).
- 8) The County Board member present will decide protests on rule interpretations. If a Board member is unavailable, the tournament director will make the decision.
- 9) A decision as to whether or not to call a tournament game because of rain or playing conditions will be made by the County Board member in attendance. If a Board member is not present, then the tournament director will make the decision.
- 10) Playing regulations not noted above are governed by the State rulebook.

COUNTY TOURNAMENT SITE REQUIREMENTS

All Areas within CCJBA are encouraged to apply to host annual County Tournaments. Requests to host these tournaments are submitted to the CCJBA Board, and are generally due by January of each year. The Board selects tournament sites from the requests received. All sites must generally satisfy the following requirements:

- 1) At least two fields must be available for tournament games.
- 2) The fields must have suitable playing conditions, including:
 - a) Good quality bases, and
 - b) An official size pitching rubber.
- 3) Adequate field preparations must be provided, including:
 - a) Dragging the fields between games;
 - b) Lining properly before all games (“touch-up” between games); and
 - c) Having water available if between game watering is needed.
- 4) Adequate bleacher seating.
- 5) Adequate parking facilities.
- 6) PA systems for all games. *{not required, but encouraged}*
- 7) Concession stand and adequate toilet facilities.
- 8) Large tournament bracket (hardboard).
- 9) Convene a coaches meeting prior to the first day of the tournament.
- 10) Provide an adequate number of good quality baseballs.
- 11) Provide official scorekeepers for all games. *{not required, encouraged}*

Areas hosting County Tournaments are responsible for all costs, except trophies. CCJBA may reimburse Areas for all, or a portion of, the costs of umpires and baseballs.

CLACKAMAS COUNTY FIELD DIRECTIONS

This section provides directions to most of the playing fields used by teams participating in the Clackamas County Junior Baseball Association. Questions or clarifications on specific field locations should be directed to the applicable coach or Area Head where the field is located.

CANBY

Directions to Canby fields are written relative to Hwy 99E in Canby. For teams traveling on I-5, take the Aurora/Canby exit, travel east to Aurora/Hwy 99E, turn left and follow 99E north approximately 4 miles to Canby. Follow directions below to specific fields.

Ackerman Middle School: From Hwy 99E, turn south on Ivy (at the 7-11 store). Go about ½-mile to 13th and turn left (east) onto this street. The school is one block on the left. The field is behind the school.

Baker Prairie School: From Hwy 99E, turn south onto Pine Street. Follow Pine Street south (Pine becomes 3rd Avenue and then Redwood Street) to Township Road. Turn left (east) on Township, then take the first right into the Baker Prairie School complex. The field is on the south end of the school. Parking is available in the school parking lot.

Canby High School: From Hwy 99E, turn south onto Birch Street (at McDonalds), continue south past the Fine Arts Center Parking Lot and turn left. Go behind the Fine Arts Center, the JV Field is the first field, the Varsity Field is located by the tennis courts.

Empey (Centennial) Field: From Hwy 99E, turn north on Elm Street. Follow Elm St. to the “T” intersection at 5th Avenue. Elm St. ends at the Knight/Eccles school complex. Empey Field is located behind Eccles School (Eccles is the school west of Elm St.). Parking is available on both sides of Eccles School.

Knight School (Fields A and B): From Hwy 99E, turn north on Elm Street. Follow Elm St. to the “T” intersection at 5th Avenue. Elm St. ends at the backstop of the Knight B Field. The Knight A Field is diagonal to Knight B on the north side of the complex. Parking is available on both sides of Eccles School.

Lee Fields: From Hwy 99E, turn south on Ivy (at the 7-11 store). Go south about ½- mile, turn left (east) into the Lee School parking lot. If you get to the Swim Center or the light at 13th Avenue you have traveled too far. The fields are behind the school. Parking is available next to Lee School and at Ackerman Junior High.

CANBY (cont.)

Maple St. Park: From Hwy 99E north of Canby, turn west on Territorial Road. Cross the railroad tracks and go about a mile, turn south onto Maple Street. The park is on the left.

CLACKAMAS

Happy Valley Park: Take I-205 to the Sunnyside Exit, go east on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside Rd. to 122nd, turn left. Go to King Road (fire station) and turn right. Follow King Rd. to 132nd, turn left. Follow 132nd north to Ridgecrest Road, turn right. Happy Valley Park is on the right.

Mt. Scott School: Take I-205 to the Sunnyside Exit, go east on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside Rd. to Stevens Road, turn left. The school is on the left side of Stevens Rd.

Oregon Trail Elementary: Take I-205 to the Sunnyside Exit, go east on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside Rd. to 152nd, turn right. The school is on the right.

Sunnyside School: Take I-205 to the Sunnyside Exit, go east on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside Rd. to 132nd, turn right. The school is on the right near this corner; the field is behind the school.

Sunrise Junior High: Take I-205 to the Sunnyside Exit, go east on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside Rd. to 132nd, turn right. Go about ¼ mile to the school on the right. The field is behind the school.

COLTON

General directions to Colton: From Oregon City, take Hwy 213 south towards Molalla. Follow Hwy 213 past Mulino, turn left (east) onto Union Mills Road. Follow Union Mills Road to the “four corners” at Meadowbrook, go straight onto Hwy 211. Follow Hwy 211 for about 5 miles to Colton. In Colton there is a flashing yellow light on Hwy 211; Colton Lutheran Church is on the right, and Colton Market is on the left.

Colton Elementary (Midget field): Follow the directions (above) to Colton. Continue on Hwy 211 past the flashing yellow light, turn right onto Schieffer Road. Follow Schieffer Road to Grays Hill Road, turn right. The school will be on the right side of Grays Hill Road; the field is behind the school. The Midget field is the one the farthest away, near the back fence.

Colton Middle School (Junior and Senior field): Follow the directions (above) to Colton. Continue on Hwy 211 past the flashing yellow light, turn right onto Schieffer Road. Follow Schieffer Road about ½-mile to the school on the right; 21580 Schieffer Road.

COUNTRY CHRISTIAN

Junior and Senior fields:

(From the North) Take the I-205 Park Place Exit (#10) and follow Hwy 213 south towards Molalla. Go through Mulino. The field is about 3 miles farther on the right off Hwy 213.

(From the South) From the intersection of Hwys 213 and 211 (Blackman's Corner), go north on Hwy 213 towards Oregon City. The field is about 1 ½ miles farther on the left off Hwy 213.

Midget field:

(From the North) Take the I-205 Park Place Exit (#10) and follow Hwy 213 south towards Molalla. Go through Mulino, and turn left onto Union Mills Road. Follow Union Mills to Hwy 211, go straight towards Colton. The school and field are about 200 feet further on the left.

(From the South) From the intersection of Hwys 213 and 211 (Blackman's Corner), go east on Hwy 211 through Molalla. Go about 3 miles to Meadowbrook store, turn right towards Colton. The school and field are about 200 feet farther on the left.

FRANKLIN

Not available at time of printing. Please consult the CCJBA website (ccjba.org) or contact the Franklin coach for directions.

GLADSTONE

Dierickx: North on McLoughlin (99E) to Gladstone. At the second stoplight past the Clackamas River bridge, turn right onto Gloucester. Go one block to Risley, turn left. The field is on the right.

Gladstone High School: North on McLoughlin (99E) to Gladstone. At the second stoplight past the Clackamas River bridge, turn right onto Gloucester. Go to Portland Avenue and turn left. The school is on the right off Portland Ave.

Kraxberger: From I-205, take the Gladstone Exit. Go west towards Gladstone. At the first stoplight, turn right onto Oatfield Road. Go about 1 mile and turn right at the stoplight onto Webster Road. The school is on the left side of Webster Road.

Meldrum Park: North on McLoughlin (99E) to Gladstone. At the second stoplight past the Clackamas River bridge, turn left on Gloucester. Go to River Road ("T") and turn right. Go 1 block, turn left on Meldrum Bar Park Road.

LAKE OSWEGO and LAKERIDGE

Lake Oswego High School: From I-5 northbound, take the Lake Oswego/Hwy 217 exit (exit #292) and stay in the left lane. At the top of the exit, turn left (east) onto Kruse Way. Follow Kruse Way

Lakeridge High School (JV Field): From I-205 westbound, take the Stafford Road Exit (Exit #3). Turn right (north) towards Lake Oswego and proceed on Stafford Road for approximately 2.1 miles. Turn left on Overlook Drive (there is a stoplight at this intersection). Proceed about 0.2 mile, the JV field is on the left side of the road. Seating is limited, so consider bringing a chair.

Waluga (Federal games only): From I-5 northbound, take the Lake Oswego/Hwy 217 exit (exit #292), turn left (east) onto Kruse Way. Follow Kruse Way about 1 mile, turn right onto Carmen Drive. Follow Carmen Drive one block to a four-way stop, turn left onto Quarry Road. Follow Quarry for 0.3 mile, Waluga Park is on the right.

Westlake (All National and American games): From I-5 northbound, take the Lake Oswego/Hwy 217 exit (exit #292), turn left (east) onto Kruse Way. Follow Kruse Way for about 1 mile, turn left onto Carmen Drive. Follow Carmen Drive for one block to a four-way stop, turn left onto Parkview Drive. Follow Parkview for 0.2 mile, turn right on Bunick. Westlake Park is on the left.

MID-VALLEY

Gervais Fields

From the Oregon City area, take Hwy 99E south through Woodburn about 3 miles to a stoplight. Turn right on Gervais/Mt. Angel Road. Go west one block to the high school (on the left) for the **SENIOR** and **JUNIOR** fields. For the **MIDGET** fields, continue west past the high school another block to the grade school. Turn left at 1st Street, the field is behind the school.

Woodburn Fields

Centennial Park: **From I-5**, take the Woodburn Exit (#271). Go east about 1 mile on Hwy 214 (towards Woodburn) to the third traffic light, turn right onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about 1 mile on Settlemier to Parr Road (flashing light), turn right onto Parr Road. Follow Parr Road about ½ mile (past two schools: Heritage and Valor) to the park entrance on the left.

Centennial Park (cont.): **From Hwy 99E**, turn west at the Hwy 214 junction (at the Safeway store). Go about 1 mile, turn left at the light onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about 1 mile on Settlemier to Parr Road (flashing light), turn right onto Parr Road. Follow Parr Road about ½ mile (past two schools: Heritage and Valor) to the park entrance on the left.

French Prairie Middle School: **From I-5**, take the Woodburn Exit (#271). Go east about 1 mile on Hwy 214 (towards Woodburn) to the school on the left, the fields are behind the school (the school is just past the fire station, and before the third traffic light).

From Hwy 99E, turn west at the Hwy 214 junction (at the Safeway store). Go about 1 mile, the school is on the right, the fields are behind the school.

Settlemier Park: **From I-5**, take the Woodburn Exit (#271). Go east about 1 mile on Hwy 214 (towards Woodburn) to the third traffic light, turn right onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about ¾ mile on Settlemier to the park on your left.

From Hwy 99E, turn west at the Hwy 214 junction (at the Safeway store). Go about 1 mile, turn left at the light onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about ¾ mile on Settlemier to the park on your left.

Valor Middle School: **From I-5**, take the Woodburn Exit (#271). Go east about 1 mile on Hwy 214 (towards Woodburn) to the third traffic light, turn right onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about 1 mile on Settlemier to Parr Road (flashing light), turn right onto Parr Road. Follow Parr Road about ½ mile to Valor Middle School. Use the last driveway for Valor School, park at the side of the school.

From Hwy 99E, turn west at the Hwy 214 junction (at the Safeway store). Go about 1 mile, turn left at the light onto Settlemier Ave. Go south about 1 mile on Settlemier to Parr Road (flashing light), turn right onto Parr Road. Follow Parr Road about ½ mile to Valor Middle School. Use the last driveway for Valor School, park at the side of the school.

Woodburn High School: **From I-5**, take the Woodburn Exit (#271). Go east about 1-1/2 miles on Hwy 214 (towards Woodburn) to the school on the left. The fields are located off the back parking lot of the school.

From Hwy 99E, turn west at the Hwy 214 junction (at the Safeway store). Go about ¾ mile, the school is on the right side of the highway. The fields are located off the back parking lot of the school.

MILWAUKIE

Ardenwald: Take I-205 north to the Milwaukie Exit (Hwy 224). Go west on Hwy 224 to Harrison Street in Milwaukie, turn right. Follow Harrison St. to 32nd Street, turn left. Follow 32nd to Wake Street, turn right. The school is on the left on Wake Street.

Hector Campbell: Take I-205 north to the Sunnyside Exit. Turn left on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside west, go across 82nd Ave where Sunnyside becomes Harmony Road. Follow Harmony Rd. west to the stoplight at Linwood; go straight onto Railroad Avenue. Go about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, the school is on the right.

Linwood: Take I-205 north to the Sunnyside Exit. Turn left on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside west, go across 82nd Ave where Sunnyside becomes Harmony Road. Follow Harmony Rd. west to the stoplight at Linwood, turn right. Go about 3 blocks, the school is on the left. Note: The **Parking Lot Field** is in the SW corner of the school property; **Water Tower Field** is in the NW corner of the school property; and **Linwood Avenue Field** is in the NE corner of the school property. Please park in the school lot or along Stanley Avenue; DO NOT park in the surrounding neighborhoods.

Lot Whitcomb: Take I-205 north to the Sunnyside Exit. Turn left on Sunnyside Road. Follow Sunnyside west, go across 82nd Ave where Sunnyside becomes Harmony Road. Follow Harmony Rd. west to the stoplight at Fuller Road, turn right. Follow Fuller Rd. to Thompson Road, turn left. The school is on the left.

North Clackamas Park: Take I-205 north to the Milwaukie Exit (Hwy 224). Go west on Hwy 224 to the stoplight at Rusk Road/North Clackamas Park, turn left. Follow Rusk Road, turn right into the park.

Rowe Junior High: Take I-205 north to the Milwaukie Exit (Hwy 224). Go west on Hwy 224 to the Lake Road Exit. At the top of the exit, turn left onto Lake Road. Follow Lake Road until you see the school on the left (near 36th Ave.).

Seth Lewelling: Take I-205 north to the Milwaukie Exit (Hwy 224). Go west on Hwy 224 to Harrison Street in Milwaukie, turn right. Follow Harrison St. to 42nd Street, turn left. Go to King Road, turn right. Go one block and turn left on 43rd. Go to Logus Road, turn right. The school is on the left side of Logus Road. **There is NO PARKING on 51st** (except Handicapped parking). Please park in the school parking lot only.

Wichita: Take I-205 north to the Johnson Creek Exit. Go west on Johnson Creek Blvd. to Wichita, turn left. Continue on Wichita to the school on the right.

MOLALLA

MHS Heckard Sports Complex: Take Hwy 213 south from Oregon City towards Molalla. Turn left on Main Street (at signal) towards city center. Turn right at Main St./Molalla Avenue intersection. Turn left on 5th Street. Go to Eckerd Ave., turn left. The field is located at the football field at 4th and Eckerd. The varsity field has dugouts. JV is the main field, directly behind the varsity outfield.

Molalla River Middle School: Take Hwy 213 south from Oregon City towards Molalla. Turn left on Main Street (at signal) towards city center. Turn left on Leroy Avenue. The school is on the left. Facing the school, the Midget field is in the southwest corner, the Junior field is located next to the main parking lot, and the Senior field is located in the northwest corner.

Sheets Field: Take Hwy 213 south from Oregon City towards Molalla. Turn left on Toliver Road (flashing yellow light). Follow Toliver until you see the field on the right, in front of the Molalla Bike Race Track and next to Molalla Elementary School.

NORTH MARION

High School: Take 99E south through Canby and Aurora, go about 2 miles. At the stoplight, turn right onto Grimm Road. Go about 1 mile, the high school is on the corner of Boones Ferry Road and Grimm.

OREGON CITY

Clackamas Community College: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver Creek Rd. (3rd light), turn left. Go about 0.5 miles on Beaver Creek Road to an entrance to CCC on the right (2nd light). Turn right and follow this road 0.1 mile to a stop sign. Turn left on Douglas Loop and immediately park on the east side of this road. Field #3 is located near the parking area. Field #2 is directly across from Field #3 (beyond centerfield of #3).

Chapin Park: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver Creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., go straight across the intersection. At the "T" (light) turn left onto Warner-Milne Rd. Go to the next light, then straight onto Warner-Parrott Rd. Go $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Chapin Park on the left. Four numbered fields: #1 is on the west side of the park; #2 and #3 are in the center; #4 is the farthest south.

OREGON CITY (cont.)

Gaffney Lane School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., turn left at the intersection. Follow Molalla Ave. approximately 0.3 mile to the second light (at Burgerville), turn right onto Gaffney Lane. Follow Gaffney Lane 0.2 mile to a “T” (stop sign) then turn left onto Berta Dr./Gaffney Lane. Follow this road for approximately 0.2 mile to the school on the right. Park in the lot, the field is behind the school. Note: Do NOT use the private drive at the west side of the school to park or drive to the field.

Gardner Junior High: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., go straight across the intersection. At the “T” (light) turn left onto Warner-Milne Rd. Go to the next light, turn right onto Linn Ave. Go 2 blocks to Hood St., turn right. Go 3 blocks to the school parking lot.

Hillendale Park: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., turn left at the intersection. Follow Molalla Ave approximately 0.2 mile to the first light, turn right onto Clairmont *{follow next directions to specific fields}*:

Front Field (#1): Follow Clairmont approximately 0.7 mile to Hillendale Park, turn right into the parking lot. The Front field is adjacent to the parking lot.

Back Field (#2): Follow Clairmont approximately 0.5 mile, turn right on Wassail. Follow Wassail 0.1 mile to the parking lot on the left. The Back field is north of the parking lot adjacent to the tennis court.

John McLoughlin: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., go straight across the intersection. At the “T” (light) turn left onto Warner-Milne Rd. Go to the next light, go straight onto Warner-Parrott Rd. Go 1 mile to the flashing red light, turn left onto South End Rd. Go about 1 mile to the school, turn left into the parking lot. Field is near the east end of the parking lot.

King: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., go straight across the intersection. At the “T” (light) turn left onto Warner-Milne Rd. Go to the next light, go straight onto Warner-Parrott Rd. Go 1 mile to the flashing red light, turn right onto South End Rd. Go 1 block, turn right into the school. Field is behind the school.

OREGON CITY (cont.)

Mt. Pleasant: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn right. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Molalla Ave., go straight across the intersection. At the “T” (light) turn left onto Warner-Milne Rd. Go to the next light, turn right onto Linn Ave. Go about 200 feet and take the first left into the parking area. The “front” field is near the road; the “back” field is near the covered play area.

Ogden Middle School: *(From the north)* Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the second light, turn right onto Redland Rd. Go about 1 mile to Holly Lane, turn right. Go up the hill $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Donovan Rd., turn right. Go to the end of the road, fields are behind the school. Games are played on the farthest field, behind the football field.

(From the south) Follow Hwy 213 north to Beaver creek Rd., turn right. At the first light, turn left onto Maple Lane. Go about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, turn left onto Holly Lane. Go about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to Donovan Rd., turn left. Go to the end of the road, fields are behind the school. Games are played on the farthest field, behind the football field.

Oregon City High School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beaver creek Rd. (3rd light), turn left. Go about 1 mile on Beaver creek Road to Oregon City High School on the right. Turn right into the first entrance and proceed west past the tennis courts to the parking lot (Matile Field). For games on Bauer Field, turn right into the second entrance and proceed west to the parking lot beside the gym. Bauer Field is beyond the football field.

Park Place School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the first light, turn left onto Clackamas River Road. Go 0.3 mile to Melinda St., turn right. Go 0.1 mile to the stop sign at Apperson Blvd., turn right. Go 0.1 mile to LaRae St., turn left and follow this street to the school on the left. The field is at the NW corner of the large field behind the school.

Wesley Lynn Park: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east approximately 4 miles on Hwy 213 to Meyers Road (5th light, near Hagggen’s), turn right. Follow Meyers Road approximately 1.1 miles to Frontier Parkway, turn left. Follow Frontier Parkway approximately 0.3 miles to the park on the right.

Field #1 is the closest to the parking lot.

Field #2 is the farthest from the parking lot.

PUTNAM

Aldercreek Middle School: Take I-205 to the Milwaukie/Hwy 224 Exit. Go west on Hwy 224 about one mile then turn left onto Webster Road (4th stoplight). The school is on the corner of Hwy 224 and Webster. Enter the school at the second entrance near the tennis courts. The fields are behind the school.

Concord School: Take McLoughlin (99E) to Concord Road, turn east. Follow Concord to the school on the left. Park in the school lot.

Oak Grove Center (old Oak Grove School): Take McLoughlin (99E) to Oak Grove Blvd., turn west. Follow Oak Grove Blvd. 0.4 mile, turn right at the stop sign (Rupert). Go 0.1 mile, turn left on Oak Grove Blvd. Go 0.1 mile then turn right onto Arista. The fields are on the left.

Rex Putnam High: Take McLoughlin (99E) to Roethe Road, turn east. Follow Roethe about 5 blocks, the gate to the high school is on the right. Park in the school lot.

Riverside School: Take McLoughlin (99E) to Concord Road, turn west toward the Willamette River. Follow Concord to River Road ("T"); the school is near this intersection. Park in the lot at the front of the school.

View Acres School: Take McLoughlin (99E) to Concord Road, turn east. Follow Concord to Oatfield Road, turn left. Go 1 block, turn right onto View Acres Rd. View Acres Rd. becomes Hill Rd; follow this road until you see the fields on the right.

or

Take I-205 to the Clackamas/Estacada Exit (#12). At the top of the exit, turn west on Hwy 212 and continue to the T-intersection, turn right onto McKinley Ave. Follow McKinley to the four-way stop sign, continue straight. Follow McKinley to a stoplight then turn right onto Webster Road. Follow Webster to the next stoplight then turn left onto Thiessen. Continue west on Thiessen to the second stoplight then turn right onto Hill Road. Travel about ¼-mile to the baseball fields on the left.

REDLAND

Fischers Mill Fields: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Take this exit, and go east about ½ mile to the second light, turn right onto Redland Rd. Go straight through the light at Abernathy and continue onto Redland Rd. Go about 5 miles on Redland Rd. to the Redland Store and gas station. At this intersection, turn left onto Fischers Mill Road. Continue on Fischers Mill Rd. for about 1 mile. The fields will be on your right.

REDLAND (cont.)

Ogden Middle School: *(From the north)* Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east about ½ mile to the second light, turn right onto Redland Rd. Go about 1 mile to Holly Lane, turn right. Go up the hill ½ mile to Donovan Rd., turn right. Go to the end of the road, fields are behind the school. Games are played on the farthest field, behind the football field.

(From the south) Follow Hwy 213 north to Beaver Creek Rd., turn right. At the first light, turn left onto Maple Lane. Go about ½ mile, turn left onto Holly Lane. Go about 1 ½ miles to Donovan Rd., turn left. Go to the end of the road, fields are behind the school. Games are played on the farthest field, behind the football field.

Redland School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Take the exit, and go east about ½ mile to the second light, turn right onto Redland Rd. Go straight through the light at Abernathy and continue on Redland Rd. for about 5 miles. About 100 feet before the Redland store to the left will be the driveway to the school. Watch for the Redland School sign. Take the driveway (left) up the hill. The fields will be visible from the parking lot.

SELLWOOD

Duniway School: Take McLoughlin Blvd (99E) north to the Sellwood Bridge Exit. At the top of the exit, go right (west) on Tacoma. Follow Tacoma to 17th, turn right. Take 17th to Bybee, turn right. Follow Bybee across the overpass, turn right onto 27th. Follow 27th (golf course on your right) to the first stop sign, turn left to Reed College Place, then turn right. Go 1 block to Lambert and turn left to 34th. The school is at 34th and Lambert.

Lewis Elementary School: Take I-205 North to the Johnson Creek Blvd. Exit (Exit 16). At the top of the exit ramp, turn left onto Johnson Creek Blvd. Follow Johnson Creek Blvd to SE Flavel **Drive**, turn right. Follow Flavel Drive to SE 45th Ave., turn right. Follow 45th to SE Evergreen Street, turn left. The school on the right.

Sellwood Middle School: Take McLoughlin Blvd (99E) north to the Sellwood Bridge Exit. At the top of the exit, go right (west) on Tacoma. Follow Tacoma to 16th, turn left. Go 4 blocks to the school on the right (corner of 16th and Sherrett).

Sellwood Park: Take McLoughlin Blvd (99E) north to the Sellwood Bridge Exit. At the top of the exit, go right (west) on Tacoma. Follow Tacoma to 7th, turn right. Go 6 blocks north on 7th to the fields.

SELLWOOD (cont.)

Westmoreland Park: Take McLoughlin Blvd (99E) north to the Sellwood Bridge Exit. At the top of the exit, go right (west) on Tacoma. At the bottom of the overpass, take the first right. Go left on Nehalem, then turn right onto 23rd. Follow 23rd along the parking lot onto Lambert, then make a quick right on 22nd. The fields are on the right.

SILVERTON

Butte Creek School, 37569 S. Hwy 213, Mt. Angel: From the Oregon City area, take Hwy 213 south past Molalla to Marquam. Butte Creek School is past Marquam on the right side of Hwy 213.

From Hwy 99E in Canby, turn south on Ivy Street. Follow Ivy Street south and the road becomes the Canby-Marquam Highway. Follow this highway across Hwy 211 and the road becomes Kropf Road. Follow Kropf Road to Marquam, turn right onto Hwy 213. The school is on the right side of Hwy 213.

From Hwy 99E in Woodburn, turn east on Hwy 214 towards Mt. Angel. Follow Hwy 214 to Mt. Angel, turn left on E. College Street. Follow E. College Street to Meridian Road, turn right onto Meridian Road. Follow Meridian Rd, turn left onto Mt. Angel-Scotts Mills Road. Follow this road to Hwy 213, turn left onto Hwy 213. The school is on the left side of Hwy 213.

Silverton High School (James St. Field): From the Oregon City area, take Hwy 213 south to Silverton. Turn right on Meridian Road, then left on Hobart Road. Follow Hobart Road across Hwy 214, then turn left on James St. Follow James St. about 2 blocks to the fields. Games are played on the Freshman field; this is the first field you will come to on James St. (the field without bleachers).

From Woodburn, take Hwy 214 (Mt. Angel Hwy) south towards Silverton. Turn right onto Hobart Road. Follow Hobart Road to James Street, turn left on James Street. Follow James St. about 2 blocks to the fields. Games are played on the Freshman field; this is the first field you will come to on James St. (the field without bleachers).

St. Paul Church: From the Oregon City area, take Hwy 213 south to Silverton. Turn right on Meridian Road, then left on Hobart Road. Follow Hobart Road across Hwy 214, then turn left on James St. Follow James St. past the High School then turn right on Pine Street. Follow Pine St. about 3 blocks to the church on the right.

From Woodburn, take Hwy 214 (Mt. Angel Hwy) south towards Silverton. Turn right onto Hobart Road. Follow Hobart Road to James Street, turn left on James Street. Follow James St. past the High School then turn right on Pine Street. Follow Pine St. about 3 blocks to the church on the right.

SOUTH CLACKAMAS

Beavercreek School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beavercreek Rd. (3rd light), turn left. Follow Beavercreek Road past Clackamas Community College and Oregon City High School to the town of Beavercreek. Turn left at the Beavercreek store (stay on Beavercreek Rd.) and go about 1 mile to S. Yeoman Road (sharp corner), turn left. The school and fields are on the right.

Carus School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east on Hwy 213 to approximately 3 ½ miles past Clackamas Community College; the school is on the right.

Clarkes Field: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east 3 miles on Hwy 213 to Beavercreek Rd. (3rd light), turn left. Follow Beavercreek Road past Clackamas Community College and Oregon City High School to the town of Beavercreek. Turn left at the Beavercreek store (stay on Beavercreek Rd.) and go about 5 miles to Windy City Road, turn right. The school is on the left.

Mulino Grade School: Take I-205 to Park Place Exit (#10). Go east on Hwy 213. Follow Hwy 213 about 12 miles to Mulino. The field is on the left.

TUALATIN

Atfalati Park, Tualatin: **From I-5** take Exit #289, the “Nyberg Road-Tualatin-Sherwood Road” Exit. Travel east on Nyberg Road for 0.4 mile. Stay to the right as Nyberg Road turns south and becomes SW 65th Ave. Follow 65th for approximately 0.5 mile, then turn right (west) on Sagert Street. Follow Sagert Street 0.1 mile to Atfalati Park on the left.

From I-205 take Exit #3, the “Stafford Road” Exit. Travel north on Stafford Road for 0.5 mile. Turn left (west) on Borland Road and travel 2.0 miles. Turn left (south) on 65th Avenue and travel 0.1 mile. Turn right (west) on Sagert Street and travel 0.1 mile to Atfalati Park on the left.

TUALATIN (cont.)

Bridgeport Elementary, 5505 SW Borland Road, Tualatin: **From I-5** take Exit #289, the “Nyberg Road-Tualatin-Sherwood Road” Exit. Travel east on Nyberg Road for 0.4 mile. Stay to the right as Nyberg Road turns south and becomes SW 65th Ave. Follow 65th for approximately 0.5 mile, then turn left (east) on Borland Road. Follow Borland Road for 0.5 mile then turn left (north) on 56th Avenue. Travel 0.1 mile to the school.

From I-205 take Exit #3, the “Stafford Road” Exit. Travel north on Stafford Road for 0.5 mile. Turn left (west) on Borland Road and travel 1.5 miles. Turn right (north) on 56th Avenue and travel 0.1 mile to Bridgeport Elementary School.

Ibach Park, 10455 SW Ibach Street, Tualatin: From I-5 take Exit #289, the “Nyberg Road-Tualatin-Sherwood Road” Exit. Travel west on Nyberg Road 0.2 mile and stay to the left onto Tualatin-Sherwood Road. Go approximately 0.4 mile then turn left (south) onto SW Boones Ferry Road. Go 1.5 miles then turn right (east) onto Ibach Street. Follow Ibach Street 0.1 mile and take the 2nd right to stay on Ibach Street. Travel 0.3 mile to Ibach Park on the right.

Jurgens Park, 17255 SW Jurgens Avenue, Tualatin: From I-5 take Exit #289, the “Nyberg Road-Tualatin-Sherwood Road” Exit. Travel west on Nyberg Road 0.2 mile and stay to the left onto Tualatin-Sherwood Road. Go approximately 1.5 mile, turn right (north) on Teton Avenue. Follow Teton Ave. 1.3 miles then turn right (east) on Tualatin Road. Go approximately 0.1 mile then take an immediate left (north) on Jurgens Avenue. Go 0.4 mile to Jurgens Park at the end of the street.

Tualatin High School: From I-5 take Exit #289, the “Nyberg Road-Tualatin-Sherwood Road” Exit. Travel west on Nyberg Road 0.2 mile and stay to the left onto Tualatin-Sherwood Road. Go approximately 0.4 mile then turn left (south) onto SW Boones Ferry Road. Go 1.6 miles to Tualatin High school on the left. Use the North parking lot for the Freshman Field, and the South parking lot for the JV Field.

WEST LINN

Athey Creek Middle School: From I-205, take the Stafford Road Exit (Exit #3). Go north on Stafford Road about ½ mile to a four-way intersection. Turn left onto Borland Road. Follow Borland about ¼ mile to Athey Creek Middle School on the north (right) side of Borland Road.

WEST LINN (cont.)

Oppenlander Fields: From I-205, take the 10th Street Exit in West Linn. Go north on 10th Street to the T-intersection at Salamo Road. Turn right onto Salamo Road. Follow Salamo up the hill and past the Safeway store to a four-way stop sign at Rosemont Road. Turn right (east) onto Rosemont and travel about 200 yards to the entrance to the Oppenlander Fields complex on the left (north).

Rosemont Ridge Middle School: From I-205, take the 10th Street Exit in West Linn. Go north on 10th Street to the T-intersection at Salamo Road. Turn right onto Salamo Road. Follow Salamo up the hill and past the Safeway store. The school is on the left near the four-way intersection of Salamo and Rosemont Road.

Willamette Park: From I-205, take the 10th Street Exit. Go south on 10th Street to Willamette Falls Drive, turn right. Go 2 blocks on Willamette Falls Drive, turn left on 12th Street. Follow 12th Street for 5 blocks to Willamette Park.

WHISKEY HILL

91 School: From Canby, go south on 99E to Barlow Road, turn left. Go about 4 miles to Whiskey Hill Road, turn west (right). Go 1 mile to the 91 school.

WILSON

Gabriel Park (upper field): (*Senior Federal*). From I-5 northbound, take the Terwilliger Blvd. Exit. Turn left on Terwilliger Blvd. Proceed on Terwilliger, then turn left on Barbur Blvd. (1st light). Turn right on Bertha (1st light). Turn left on Vermont. Go past the stop sign and continue on Vermont. Turn left on 42nd, and into the parking lot.

Jackson Middle School: From I-5 northbound, take the Barbur Blvd. Exit. Proceed straight on Barbur Blvd. Turn right on Huber (a sign on the right reads "PCC Sylvania Capitol Hwy"; the intersection is just past McDonalds on the right). Get into the middle lane, proceed straight on Huber then turn right on 40th. Turn left on Alfred.

Pendleton Park: From Gabriel Park (see directions above), go west on Vermont. Turn north on 50th, then turn west on Iowa. The field is on the right.

Smith Elementary School: From I-5 northbound, take the Capitol Highway Exit. Turn left off the ramp onto SW Taylors Ferry Road. Turn right on SW 48th (1/4-mile), then turn left onto SW Orchid Street. Follow SW Orchid to the school on the corner at SW 52nd. The field is behind the school, and can be seen from SW 52nd.

WILSONVILLE

Wilsonville High School (Senior Federal only): From I-5, take the Wilsonville Exit (#283). Go east on Wilsonville Road about one mile to Wilsonville High School on the right (6800 SW Wilsonville Road). The fields are behind the school.

Wilsonville Memorial Park: From I-5, take the Wilsonville Exit (#283). Go east on Wilsonville Road to the 3rd stoplight (at the library), turn right onto Memorial Drive. The entrance to the park is on the left after about 100 yards.

Wood Middle School: From I-5, take the Wilsonville Exit (#283). Go west on Wilsonville Road about 1 ½ miles to Wood Middle School on the right (11055 SW Wilsonville Rd).
